In the present study, achievement means to examine the effectiveness of implementation of collaborative learning strategy on achievement in English language among secondary school students.

5. Interest

According to this study ,it is the feeling of a person whose attention , interest or curiosity is particularly focused on learning English.

METHODOLOGY OF THE STUDY

SAMPLE SELECTED FOR THE STUDY

The sample for the study will be comprised of 250 students of standard of standard IX from different schools in Ernakulam district. Convenient sampling technique will be adopted. While selecting the sample , due representation will be given to variables like gender and type of management.

VARIABLES OF THE STUDY

- 2. Activity Oriented Method

Dependent Variables

1. Achievement in English Language

2. Interest in English Language

TOOLS USED FOR THE STUDY

- Achievement Test on English for IX th standard students will be prepared and validated by the investigator.
- Lesson transcript based on activity- oriented method on English for IX th standard students will be prepared and validated by investigator.

PROCEDURE

The sample will be divided into control group and experimental group. Achievement test and inventory in English will be administrated as pre- test to experimental and control group. Learning The experimental group will be treated with Collaborative learning strategy and activity oriented method will use for control. After the treatment , same achievement test and interest inventory in English will be used as post- test. The two learning units from English of Standard Ix will be considered for preparing 8 lesson transcripts. The duration of each collaborative session will be 30 minutes.

STATISTICAL TECHNIQUES

The present study recommends the use of following statistical techniques to realize the objectives set for the investigation
